What is KYMRIAH?

KYMRIAH is made from your own white blood cells and is a prescription cancer treatment used in patients up to 25 years of age who have acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) that has relapsed (went into remission, then came back) or is refractory (did not go into remission with other leukemia treatments).

Important Safety Information

What is the most important information I should know about KYMRIAH?

KYMRIAH may cause side effects that are severe or life-threatening, such as cytokine release syndrome (CRS) and neurological toxicities. Call your health care provider or get emergency help right away if you get any of the following signs and symptoms of:

- Cytokine Release Syndrome:
- Difficulty breathing
- Severe nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- Fever (100.4°F/38°C or higher)
- Chills/shaking chills
- Severe muscle or joint pain
- Very low blood pressure

KYMRIAH is a treatment for kids like you who have had other treatments that have not been able to beat their cancer. KYMRIAH is used in kids who have *relapsed* or *refractory* B-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia. "Relapsed or refractory" means that your cancer is tough, and other treatments haven't been able to beat it.

KYMRIAH is not like other medicines you may have tried. KYMRIAH uses your own body's strength to fight your cancer. Before you get KYMRIAH, you may go see a different doctor who will take some of your cells from your blood so they can be taught how to look for your cancer cells. Once your cells know how to find your cancer cells, they will be put back into your body to start fighting your cancer.

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

After you get your new KYMRIAH cells, you may feel bad in different ways including feeling sick, tired, or very warm. Sometimes these feelings will go away on their own, or you may need to go back to the hospital for treatment, but your treatment team is here to help you if they don't. Let your team know how you feel after you get KYMRIAH.

After treatment, you will have to stay in or near the hospital for at least 4 weeks so your doctor can check if your treatment is working and help you with any side effects. Your parent or caregiver should use the information on the following pages to help answer questions you may have.

Summary of Important Safety Information

What is **KYMRIAH**?

• Hemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis (HLH)/Macrophage Activation Syndrome (MAS): Be sure to discuss with your health care provider the possibility of developing this life-threatening condition, and thereafter, your doctor will monitor you for the

• Allergic Reactions: Serious allergic reactions, including anaphylaxis, which is a life-threatening allergic reaction, may occur after you receive KYMRIAH. Some signs and symptoms may include difficulty breathing, very low blood pressure, dizziness, swelling under skin, rash, nausea, and vomiting. You should seek emergency medical

• Serious Infections: KYMRIAH can increase the risk of life-threatening infections that may lead to death. Tell your health care provider right away if you develop fever,

• Prolonged Low Blood Cell Counts (Cytopenias): KYMRIAH can lower 1 or more types of your blood cells (red blood cells, white blood cells, or platelets). After treatment, your health care provider may test your blood to check cell counts. Tell your health care provider right away if you get a fever or other symptoms of an infection, are feeling tired, weak, or short of breath, or have unusual bruising

• Hypogammaglobulinemia: A condition in which the level of immunoglobulins (antibodies) in your blood is low and the risk of infection is increased. It is expected that you may develop hypogammaglobulinemia with KYMRIAH, and you may need to receive immunoglobulin replacement for an indefinite amount of time following treatment with KYMRIAH. Tell your health care provider about your treatment with

• Secondary Cancers: KYMRIAH may increase your risk of getting cancers, including certain types of blood cancers. Your health care provider should monitor you for this

Summary of Important Safety Information (continued)

What are other serious side effects of KYMRIAH? (continued)

• Effects on Ability to Drive and Use Machines: Do not drive, operate heavy machinery, or do other dangerous things for 8 weeks after you get KYMRIAH because the treatment can cause temporary memory and coordination problems, including sleepiness, confusion, weakness, dizziness, and seizures

How will I get KYMRIAH?

- Since KYMRIAH is made from your own white blood cells, your health care provider has to take some of your blood. This is called "leukapheresis." It takes 3 to 6 hours and may need to be repeated. A tube (intravenous catheter) will be placed in your vein to collect your blood
- Your blood cells are frozen and sent to the manufacturing site to make KYMRIAH. It takes about 3 to 4 weeks from the time your cells are received at the manufacturing site and shipped to your health care provider, but the time may vary
- While waiting for KYMRIAH to be made, your health care provider may give you therapy to stabilize your cancer
- In addition, before you get KYMRIAH, your health care provider may give you chemotherapy for a few days to prepare your body. When your body is ready, your health care provider will give you KYMRIAH through a tube (intravenous catheter) in your vein. This usually takes less than 1 hour
- You should plan to stay within 2 hours of the location where you received your treatment for at least 4 weeks after getting KYMRIAH. Your health care provider will check to see if your treatment is working and help you with any side effects that occur

Summary of Important Safety Information (continued) What are the possible or reasonably likely side effects of KYMRIAH?

The most common side effects of KYMRIAH include:

- Difficulty breathing
- Fever (100.4°F/38°C or higher)
- Chills/shaking chills
- Confusion
- Severe nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

These are not all the possible side effects of KYMRIAH. Talk to your health care provider for medical advice about side effects.

What should I tell my health care provider before receiving KYMRIAH?

- Tell your health care provider if you are pregnant, planning to be pregnant, or who are pregnant or breastfeeding. Talk to your health care provider about birth control and pregnancy
- and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements

What should I be aware of after receiving KYMRIAH?

- Some commercial HIV tests may cause a false positive HIV test result
- Do not donate blood, organs, tissues, sperm, oocytes, and other cells








